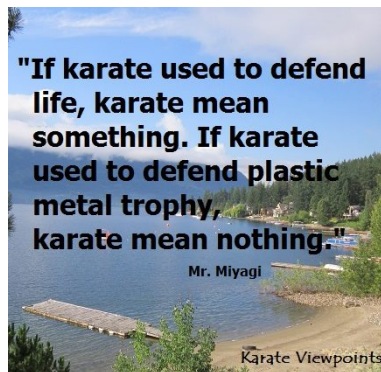

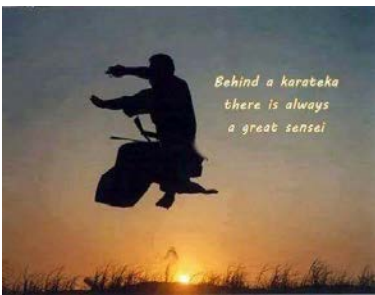
## Belt Grading Results
